We shall not sleep, though poppies grow*

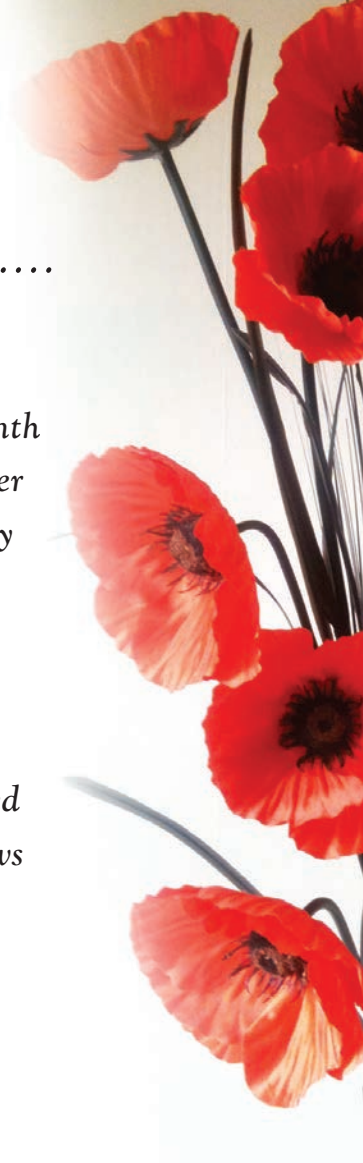

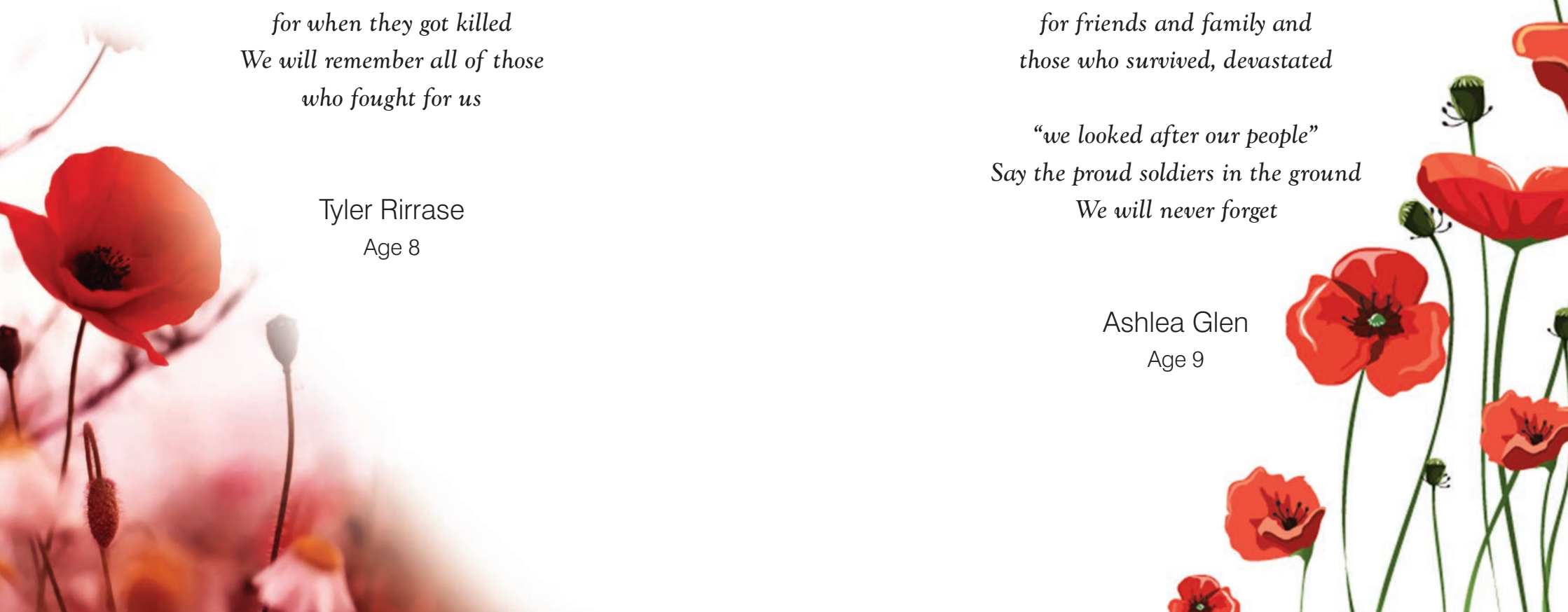
We will remember....

We will never forget*

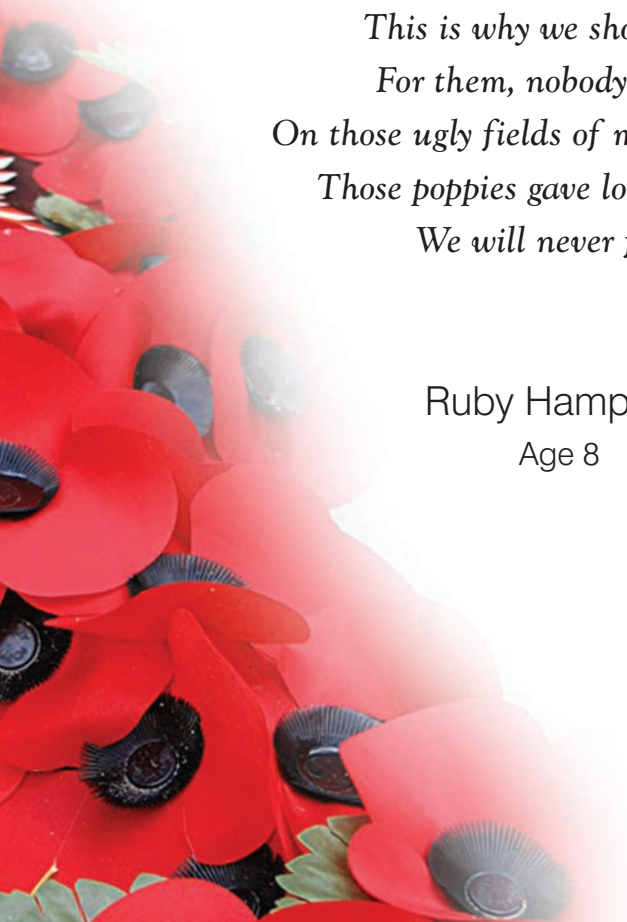

Sometimes only 18, 19*

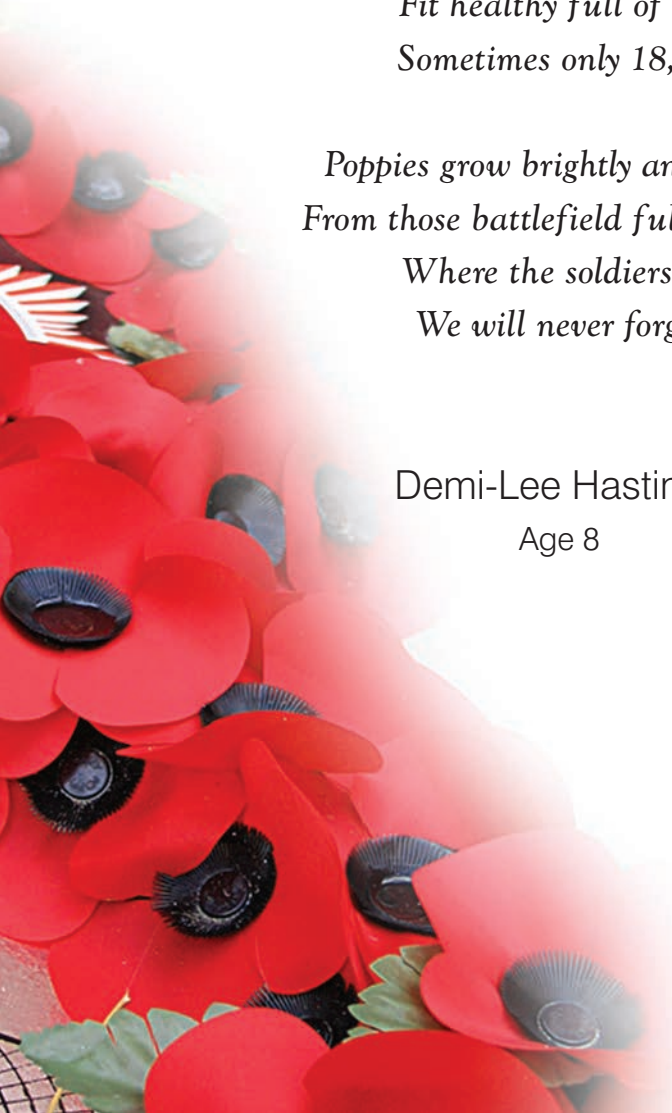
*Poppies grow brightly and boldly

We will remember those blood red fields*

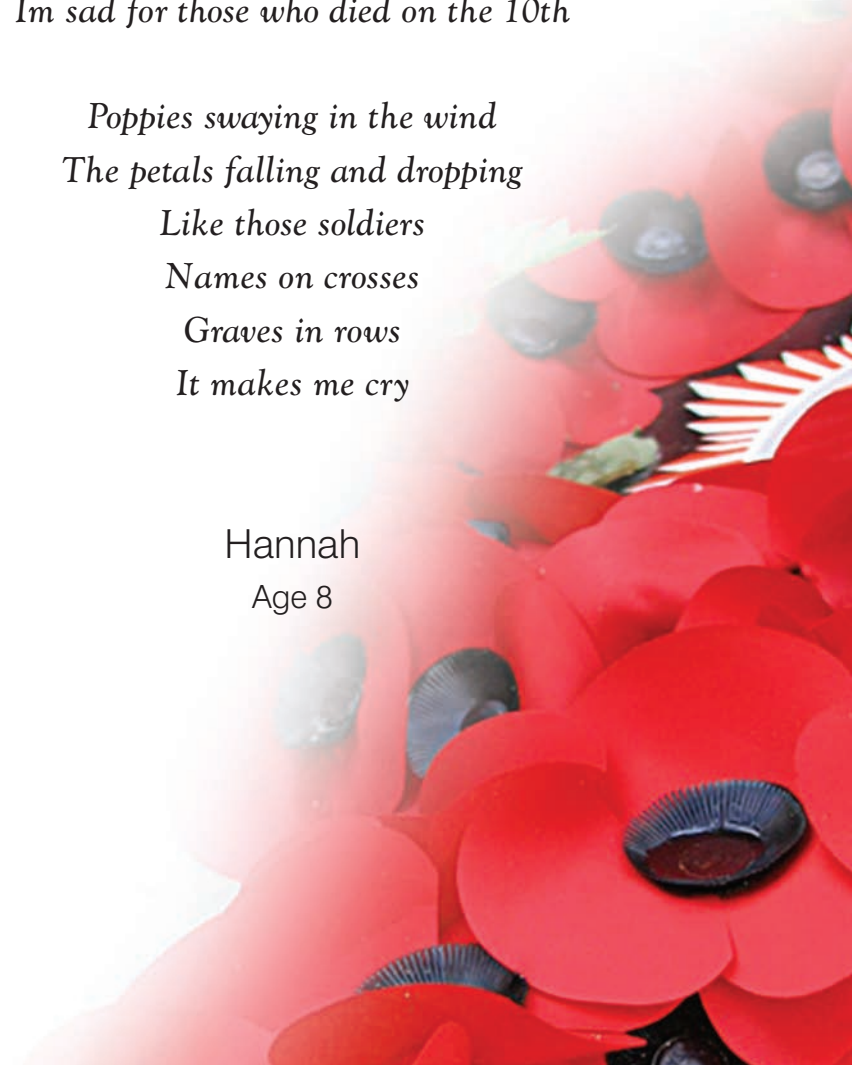
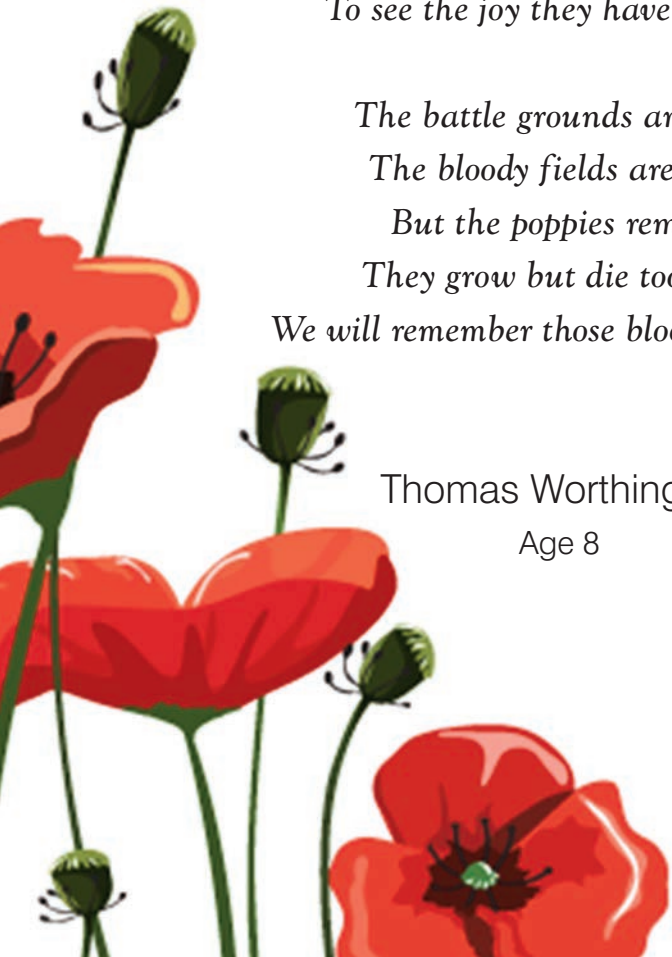
