# FREE WILL-WRITING SERVICE



The Royal British Legion is a member of The National Free Wills Network, which means we could help you to make your Will free of charge.

If you need to write your Will, we can put you in touch with a solicitor in your area who can draw one up for free, through The National Free Wills Network. The Legion then covers the cost of writing your Will, at a discounted rate.

## How it works

1. Return the form enclosed to us, or call Nicola Hall on **020 3207 2253** to let us know you are interested in this service or email [nhall@britishlegion.org.uk](mailto:nhall@britishlegion.org.uk)
2. You will receive a letter detailing the six participating solicitors closest to you.
3. You make an appointment with one of those firms to draw up or amend your Will.
4. The Royal British Legion pays for your Will to be written, at a special rate agreed with the solicitor.

Please note that this is a limited offer and only applies to simple Wills (that is, Wills that do not have to deal with any complex issues).
