Some of those who fought, and defended Hong Kong and subsequently became prisoners of war, are now finding that due to their increased age, they are unable to cope with their disabilities, failing health and loneliness. Many are now extremely elderly and frail. We also support those ex-servicemen who served in the British Garrison prior to the Handover and their dependants who have fallen on hard times including widows of ex-servicemen whose husbands have died unexpectedly and been left to raise young children. We wish to stress that our beneficiaries are all **Hong Kong residents**.

The Director of Social Welfare has given approval to three organisations to sell flags in Hong Kong Island Region, Kowloon Region and the New Territories Region respectively on **13 November 2021** and we are authorised to conduct a flag sale on Hong Kong Island on that day.
