

Minutes of a meeting held on 22<sup>nd</sup> July 1938

2. Matters arising -
  - a. The Hon. Sec<sup>y</sup> was instructed to ask H.Q. again whether papers relating to the case of M<sup>rs</sup> Ridler should be transferred to H.Q. or to the nearest branch to Marlow, Bucks - proposed by M<sup>rs</sup> Meek, seconded M<sup>rs</sup> Napier.
  - b. The case of M<sup>rs</sup> Bidmead was discussed. The Hon. Sec<sup>y</sup> agreed to see her & urge ~~her~~ her to apply for Public Assistance.
  - c. F. Dallimore - has reported cessation of treatment and instructions to appear

before a Medical Board; information as to the result is awaited.

(d) Mervyn Jones. The Hon Sec. reported that a grant of £25 towards second year college fees had been paid by Regional H.Q. direct to the college, the parent being required to give a statement of expenditure and receipts.

e. M<sup>rs</sup> H. Blunt. Grant has been renewed.

3. The Hon. Sec<sup>y</sup> reported that the Standing Committee had made a grant of 7/6 (food voucher) to M<sup>rs</sup> Mattheos. This was approved.

4. An application by M<sup>rs</sup> W. Greer for assistance in purchasing a surgical brass was discussed.

The Standing Committee was instructed to act on receipt of certain particulars required by the Guide to Benevolent Work.

5. The Standing Committee was empowered to deal with applications for renewal of school grants when received.
