

Minutes of a meeting held in the Comrades Club
on 17th July 1947.

Apologies were received from Adm^r Raikes, M^r. F. L. Johnston
M^r. Clifford - M^r. Napier.

1. The minutes of the last meeting were read & signed.
2. Arising from minutes - the hon. Sec^y reported that Area
H.Q. had now proceeded with the case of M^r. Thirlwell.

M^r. G. Price gave information that this applicant and M^r.
F.R. Clifford (Libberton) had been before Medical Boards.

(b) M^r. F. S. Parker - Area H.Q. state that no further action can
be taken unless deterioration in condition takes place and
is certified by his doctor.

(c) M^r. H. R. Martin - no change.

(d) M^r. F. R. Baldwin - Area state that it is impossible to
put this case forward again unless new evidence is
obtained.

3. The hon. Sec^y reported receipt of a copy of a letter

from Legion H.Q. stating that the application of Mr. Duffield had succeeded. This case was handled by the applicant himself.

(b) an application for assistance from Mr. E. J. Sutton was considered. The hon. Sec. was instructed to find out exactly what he wanted & the Standing Committee was instructed to act on the result.

(c) The matter of funeral expenses of the late Mr. Taylor (Stone Cottage, Gosley) was mentioned. The Hon. Sec. was unable to say whether the ~~total~~ £15, half each from the B.L. & half from the Public Assistance, had yet been paid.

2A. Representation of S.S. & A.F.A. The hon. Sec. reported that he had discussed the matter with Miss Albright & arranged that for the present he would ask her to appoint a representative whenever a case involving that organization came before the Committee.
