

Minutes of a meeting held in the Comrades Club
on 13th Jan^y 1947. 1948

Present. The Chairman and 7 members

1. Elections (a) Chairman - Mr. Nash proposed + Mr. Boughton seconded that the Rev. C. J. K. Burnell be re-elected - carried
(b) Hon. Secretary - Mr. Clayfield proposed and that this be held over until Major Moore is present - carried

Benevolent Cases: (2) M^{rs} E. J. Sutton. The Chairman

read a letter from Mayor H. T. Moore (hon Sec^y) stating that he cannot find any section of the Guide under which assistance could be given. It was decided that no action be taken.

(3) M^{rs} Mortimer. This case was discussed and it was decided to ask her to fill in a form of application.

5. Correspondence. A letter from the Area Secretary regarding an invalid chair lent to M^{rs} Ruck was read. It had been found that M^{rs} Ruck had moved to Hancockville. Form S. C. 1 was discussed.

6. Date of next meeting left open. Early March was suggested.
