

Minutes of a meeting held in the Comrades Club
(by permission) on Thursday 21st September. 1950

1. The minutes of the last meeting were read, approved
& signed

2. Resignation. A letter was read from Major G. H. E
Farrow tendering his resignation from the Committee
as he has left the County permanently. Appreciation
of his interest & activity for the work of the Committee
was expressed

3. Benevolent cases. (1) M^r H. S. Jones. The Chairman
reported discussions with the Applicant who is now
receiving disability pension at the rate of 55% and has

been assured that it will not be altered without notice.

The result of an X-ray examination and consequent decision of the Ministry of Pensions is awaited. It was decided that no action be taken until that decision is received.

(ii) Mr. F. G. Bremer. The Chairman stated that he had studied the correspondence relating to this man's applications for assistance during the last 2 years. He mentioned that letters regarding the case had been received from the County & Group & was inclined to think it was one which should be referred to the Emergency Help Committee. He had not yet been able to see the applicant personally but would do so.

Advised Mr. Bremer
