⑤ The Hon Secretary reported that the 3 Gift parcels had been distributed.

A letter of appreciation was read from Mr W H Millard of 4 The Pound, Dymock.

The Chairman promised to see Mr Millard with a view to offering further help if necessary.

In accordance with Area letter 3 Nov 1950 the Hon Sec reported that authority had been given for the expenditure of £20 less a debit balance of £1-16-3 leaving a net credit balance of £18-3-9.

The committee discussed the application for £2-7-2. to cover expenses to Blackpool and decided that this could not be granted.

With regard to Mr Brookes application for £2 a week whilst in hospital the Chairman said he would get in touch with Area HQ to find out if there is any provision for such a sum.

The Hon Sec was instructed to find out from Mr Price if anything had been done about Christmas gifts for

in 1950 and to put matters
in hand for a suggested allocation
in 1951.

Mrs Moore was expressed, proposed
by Mrs Clifford, seconded by
Mrs Caleyfield.
