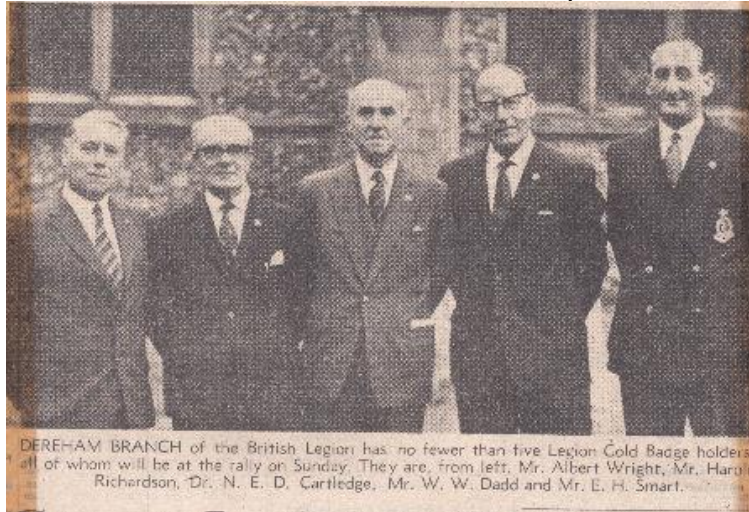


DEREHAM & DISTRICT GOLD BADGE HOLDERS

At the **September 2021** Branch meeting Lt Gen Jonathan "Jacko" Page, County President presented the Royal British Legion gold badge to the Rev. Jenny Taylor. The presentation was to recognise Jenny's dedication and service to the Royal British Legion and the Armed forces over a number of years. In 1979 she was invited to serve in Osnabruck as the first female Church Army Padre and later served in Munster, Paderborn, Sennelager Hamelin, Hannover and Herford. Whilst in Herford she was appointed the BAOR Chaplain to the RBL. With her husband David she founded the Hamelin and Hannover branches of the RBL and in 1990, after retiring from the Church Army, founded another branch in Tenerife. Jenny returned to the UK in 2005 when she joined the Dereham and District Branch

At the Branch Meeting in **July 2022**. Peter Whitwell was presented with his Gold Badge by Hugh King, Mayor of Dereham. Peter was the Branch standard bearer for many years, representing the Branch on many occasions including the Festival of Remembrance and Ypres 2018. He won the County standard bearer competition and went on to be County Parade Marshal attending many events including GP90. He also organised regular training for the Counties standard bearers.
