AnnualCounty Rededication

Sunday 17th June 2018, Wainfleet

This years Annual County Rededication will be held in Wainfleet on Sunday 17th June 2018, and it is hoped that members of the Legion from all the Branches within the County will come together for this and make it an event to remember. Those wishing to participate in the Parade to assemble in Church Lane 14.15 hours County Rededication will take place at Wainfleet Parish Church commencing at 15.00

Centotaph Parade 2018 – ticket application

In accordance with HMG plans for this year's ceremony, the number of spaces on the Veterans' Parade will remain limited at 10,000 places. As already announced, DCMS will subsequently organise a second procession drawn from the General Public which will then file past the Cenotaph. Planning is already underway to ensure de-confliction and the area of Horse Guards Parade will remain the preserve of the Veteran community as in previous years.

Branches are asked to prioritise those who served on operations, both military and civilian, followed by others representing their remaining ex-Service membership and Bereaved Spouses.

We cannot guarantee your Branch will receive the number of tickets that you initially apply for. Our intent remains to seek as broad a representation of the veteran community as is possible

All applications must be received by Monday 4th June 2018. Any application received after this date will not be accepted. We will confirm ticket allocations at the end of June and we will then be required to collect each individual's accreditation information.

If anyone wants to apply for tickets for the Veteren's Parade, please contact the secretary (Pat) in the first instance.

Some of you may be aware that there is a secondary procession planned to made up of the general public.

Applications for this will not be done through RBL and you should look online for further information.

Royal Albert Hall Remembrance: I usually get the application forms for tickets to this in June or July. The branch is allocated four tickets. The branch application is done on a first come first served basis, so if anyone is wishing to apply, please let me know. Priority will be given to those who have not been before.
