Did you know that...



Alsager RBL Branch have been delivering a digital project which helps isolated veterans stay in touch with the Armed Forces Community. The Branching Out Digitally project uses an easy-to-use set top box allowing users to make video calls to friends, family and RBL members using Facebook, WhatsApp and Zoom. The branch secured funding from the Armed Forces Covenant and help from the Cheshire East Armed Forces Lead to allow 10 portals to be installed in members' homes. With dedicated IT support to take the stress out of installation it's enabling members to attend branch meetings again using the screen on the set top box .

From the Royal British Legion Magazine September 1950

Mr Albert Webb who lives near Lympne Kent, is one of the most active workers in the Legion, despite being paralysed in both legs as a result of 1914-18 war service in the trenches with the Queen's Own Royal West Kents'. He made a cardboard model of Lydd Parish Church (which lights up when a penny is placed in the slot) and has lent it to his local branch, Ashford, for exhibition and to help the branch's benevolent fund.

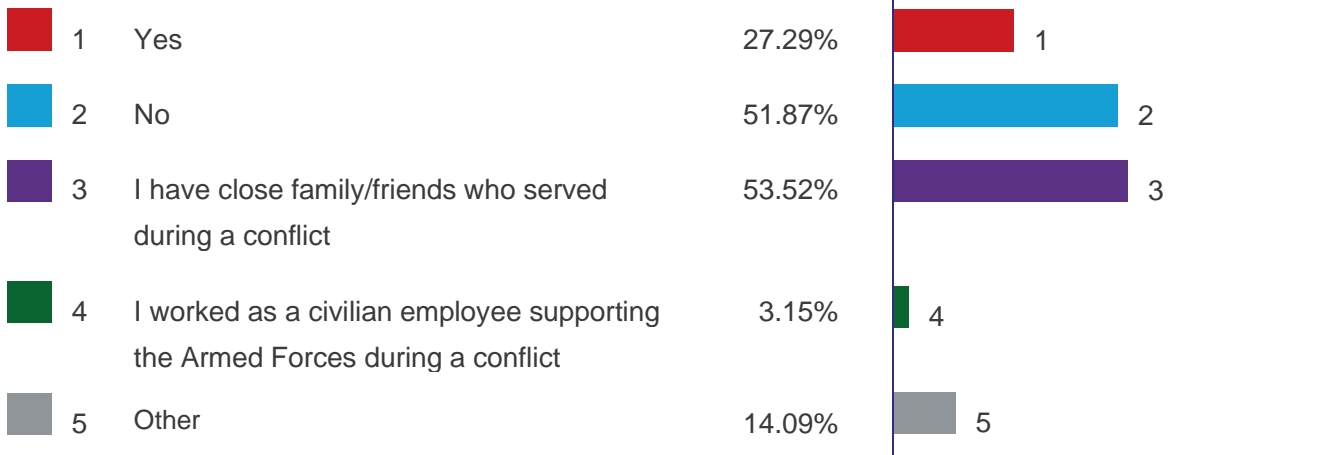
